1. Using an elevated stand 3-4 meters high, throw out 4-5 golf balls at various distances. Using regular field points estimate the distance to the balls and use them as targets. Roving is a technique where the archer wanders through the woods or down a path and shoots at various stumps etc. This is not a practice recommended with today's modern equipment. The use of suitable backstops and butt material is recommended for safety reasons.



2. Using basic construction techniques and a variety of materials build some archery butts that can be used for practice

Find a large cardboard box approximately 1 meter by 1 meter and stuff it with recycled shrink wrap. Stuff the box tightly and tape the box closed. Using heavyweight brown paper cover the box and draw outlined of animals on the six sides of the box. Using tracing paper and a large sheet of Cardboard or Corroplast make a full size silhouette of a broadside deer outlining where the Lungs and heart are. Have participants use the targets to find what their effective range is. As target faces get damaged turn the box and use other sides.
