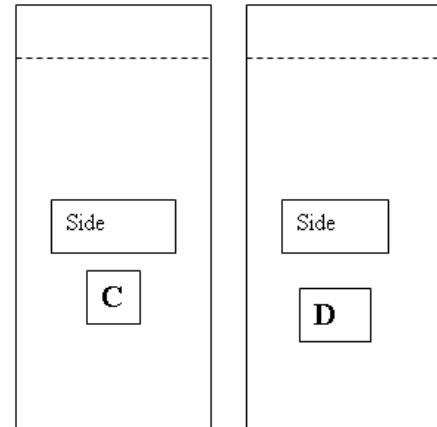
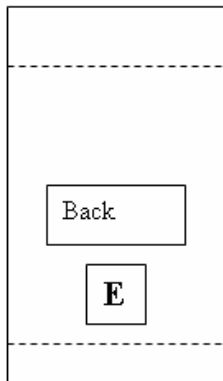


Step Outdoors

- Cut the Sides 34 X 12 cm (C) and (D)
Fold both side pieces (C) and (D) along the dotted lines at 90 degrees to form an L shape that has one leg of 32 cm and one of 2 cm



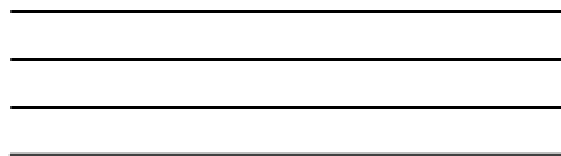
- Cut the Back 24 X 12 cm (E)



Fold both sides on the Back (E) to form a:

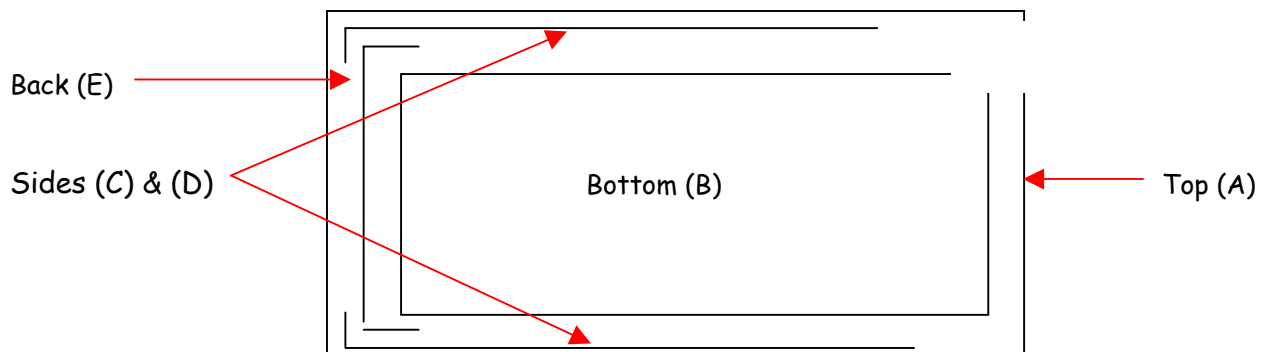


- Cut the rods to fit across the stove width approx 21 cm.

EXTENSION

Use the stove as a base for a wood fire and prepare a meal. Take the stove on a camping trip. Fill the base of the stove with wet sand to prevent the wood from buckling with the heat.

Tip: Construct a model of the stove out of paper or light cardboard and tape before you try using the sheet metal.
